2 Corinthians 5:1-21 – The Doctrine and Application of the Resurrection

Doctrine: The Resurrection

Definition

- At the return of Christ, that the righteous would put 'be further clothed, so that what is mortal may be swallowed up by **LIFE**' (v. 4).
- Christ will '**TRANSFORM** our lowly body to be like His glorious body' (Philippians 3:21)
- This is prepared for us by **GOD**, and we are given His indwelling Spirit as a guarantee (v. 5).

The Necessity of the Resurrection

- Our bodies are mortal and **CORRUPTED** (vv. 1-5).
- The story of Scripture moves from Creation to **NEW CREATION**.

The Hope of the Resurrection

- We groan in **LONGING** because of sin (v. 2).
- God has promised this; His Word is **TRUE**.

Living as Resurrection People

- This work of new creation has **BEGUN** as the Holy Spirit makes us alive in Christ (vv. 16-17).

Application: How Do We Live in Light of the Resurrection

- 1) Have **<u>COURAGE</u>** (vv. 6-8).
- 2) Seek to live in a way that **PLEASES** God (vv. 9-10).
- 3) Be on **MISSION** (vv. 11-21).
